Excerpt: .wells of Long Island obtain their supply, and this horizon is shown to have a quite uniform dip or slope towards the southeast of about 80-100 feet per mile, with a strike approximately parallel with the coast line of the adjacent mainland. On the north shore of the island, from Lloyd s Neck, westward, the top of this horizon is at a depth of approximately 200 feet below sea level while at Barren Island on the south shore it is at a depth of about 650 feet. On Plate II is depicted a map of Long Island and vicinity on which the surface locations of the flowing wells are indicated and those of equal depth are connected by lines, thus producing a series of curves of equal depth; and these curves are theoretically extended across the lower bay and the south shore of Staten...



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
