Her works include *Mother* (1911), *The Rich Mrs. Burgoyne* (1912), *Poor, Dear Margaret Kirby* (1913), *The Treasure* (1914), *Saturday s Child* (1914), *The Heart of Rachael* (1916), *Martie the Unconquered* (1917), *Josselyn s Wife* (1918), *Harriet and the Piper* (1920), *The Beloved Woman* (1921), *Beauty s Daughter* (1935), adapted for the 1935 motion picture *Navy Wife*, *Over at the Crowleys* (1941), and *The Maiden Voyage* (1942).
